WHO WE ARE

The ISTD is one of the world's leading dance examinations boards with the widest range of dance genres available. We are a registered educational charity, supporting and training our members through a wide variety of courses, teaching syllabi and techniques. Our examinations and teaching qualifications are recognised around the world.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING

Education and training is central to the ISTD's ambitions for high quality dance teaching and learning. In addition to a suite of progressive teaching qualifications for new and experienced teachers, individual ISTD faculties provide regular syllabus enhancements and a comprehensive programme of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) activities.

Faculty committees revise their syllabus vocabulary and artistic requirements from time to time to ensure they remain current and relevant for teachers and their students. Courses are provided for teachers to refresh their syllabus knowledge and learn about significant syllabus changes. In addition to syllabus courses, the ISTD offers CPD activities including opportunities to observe master classes and guest teachers; training for examiners and tutors delivering DDI and DDE qualifications; and courses in topics such as emergency first aid.

UK and international summer schools and seasonal programmes are held for students and teachers, and a range of congresses and other events provide opportunities for teachers to experience the work of different ISTD faculties; to meet each other and socialise. They often include opportunities to observe or participate in classes taken by the syllabus choreographer or guest teachers who are experts in their particular genres.

The London studios (ISTD2) is the base for our central training programmes. There are also 20 regional representatives across the UK and international representatives and organisers in different countries across the world.

TEACHING QUALIFICATIONS

The ISTD's portfolio of teaching and higher level qualifications are up-to-date, relevant to the latest developments within the sector, recognised nationally and ianternationally, and valuable to teachers and potential teachers wherever they are in their career or in the world.

- · The International Diploma in Dance Teaching, based on the regulated teaching qualifications and designed to be delivered outside the UK/EU
- Internationally recognised Associate, Licentiate and Fellowship qualifications in dance theatre and dancesport, which enable members to enter students for examinations, stand for election to faculty committees and apply to become an examiner and/or competition adjudicator.

Teachers with prior experience and additional qualifications may apply to the Education & Training department for accreditation of prior learning.

EXAMS

The examination structure of the ISTD is designed to cater equally for those who wish to progress to making dance their profession, either as a performer or dance teacher, and for those pursuing dance purely as a leisure activity.

The teaching qualifications are structured to give the new teacher the best possible foundation from which to work, with a particular emphasis on safe dance practice and the needs of the growing child.

Grade Examinations may be taken in Classical Ballet (Cecchetti and Imperial methods), Modern Theatre, Tap Dance, National Dance, Classical Greek, Classical Indian Dance, Modern Ballroom, Latin American, Disco Freestyle and Classical Sequence. Grades 1–6 are accredited by Ofqual, but some faculties have additional grades prior to Grade 1, that is, Pre-Primary and Primary.

Class Examinations may be taken in Classical Ballet (Cecchetti and Imperial methods), Classical Greek, Tap Dance (Pre-Primary and Primary) and Modern Theatre (Primary).

Medal Tests may be taken in Modern Ballroom, Latin American, Sequence, Disco Freestyle, Rock 'n' Roll, Country & Western, Classical Greek and National. The levels progress from Under 6, Under 8, Social Dance Test, Pre-Bronze Dance Test, to Bronze, Silver, Gold, Gold Star and higher awards for dancesport medals. Not all levels are applicable to all genres, please contact dance faculty for further details.

The Vocational Grades are regulated by Ofqual and include Intermediate Foundation, Intermediate, Advanced 1 and Advanced 2. These examinations form a cohesive bridge between the work covered in the grades and the work of the professional examinations.
